Siler city was founded in the mid-18th century by a German immigrant Pikard Dederic Siler. By the 20th century, it was known for its poultry industries, attracting a diverse workforce. In the 1960s, it was featured in several episodes of the Andy Griffith Show. With state routes connecting to Greensboro and Research Triangle Park, it has become a suburb for those areas. The state has created the Chatham-Siler city Megasite for Advanced Manufacturing spurring several large investments.
